Privacy Statement

At Mawdsley Brooks & Co Limited (also referred to as 'Mawdsleys', 'We', 'Us' 'Our'), we take your privacy seriously. This Privacy Statement explains our practices regarding the collection, use, and protection of your personal information.

1. Information We Collect

This privacy statement aims to give you information on how Mawdsleys collects and processes your personal data when you interact or otherwise do business with us, including any data you may provide through the use of our website. We operate on a B2B basis, and we do not knowingly collect data relating to consumers or children.

We may collect personal information, including but not limited to

- Your name
- Your email address

2. How We Use Your Information

Under data protection law, we can only use your personal data if we have a proper reason, e.g.:

- Where it is necessary for our legitimate interests (or those of a third party) such as a business or commercial reason and your interests and fundamental rights do not override those interests.
- Where we need to comply with a legal or regulatory obligation.
- Generally, we do not rely on consent as a legal basis for processing your personal data other
 than in relation to sending third party direct marketing communications to you via email or
 text message where you operate as a sole trader or partnership. You have the right to
 withdraw consent to marketing at any time by contacting us.

3. Data Security

We have put in place appropriate security measures to prevent your personal data from being accidentally lost, used, or accessed in an unauthorised way, altered, or disclosed. In addition, we limit access to your personal data to those employees, agents, contractors and other third parties who have a business need to know. They will only process your personal data on our instructions, and they are subject to a duty of confidentiality. We have put in place procedures to deal with any suspected personal data breach and will notify you and any applicable regulator of a breach where we are legally required to do so.

4. Sharing Your Information
